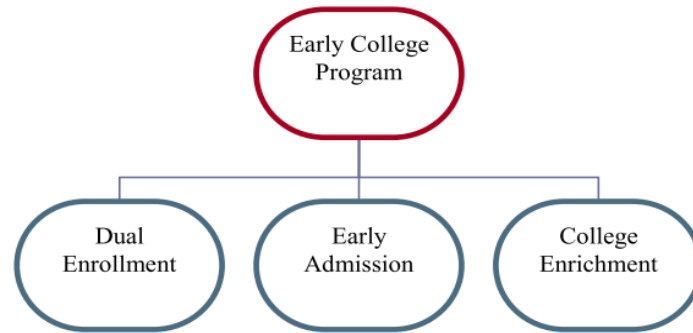




Early College Opportunities



Dual enrollment -The Dual Enrollment program at State College of Florida, Manatee-Sarasota (SCF) allows qualified high school juniors and seniors to enroll in selected college courses to satisfy high school graduation requirements and the associate degree. Most college costs are waived. Eligible High school students will be permitted to enroll in dual enrollment courses for a maximum of six (6) terms, which includes two (2) summer terms. **Students are allowed to take a maximum of two courses per term on an SCF campus.**

Career dual enrollment is a curricular option of elective credits toward earning the high school diploma and completing a career-preparatory certificate program. Career dual enrollment is not intended to enable students to take isolated courses unrelated to a program.

Early Admission is a form of dual enrollment where **qualified high school seniors** enroll at SCF on a **full-time basis (12 credits)** not to exceed sixteen (16) credit hours. Students must have completed six (6) semesters of high school credit and enroll in courses used toward high school graduation requirements and the associate degree. Requirements to participate in the Early Admission Program are the same as the requirements to participate in the Dual Enrollment Program. Most college costs are waived.

College Enrichment allows qualified high school students to enroll in approved courses that are selected to add depth to their high school academic program. Credits earned will apply toward an associate degree, but will not be creditable toward high school graduation requirements. **Students are responsible for all college-related costs including tuition, fees, and books.**

Academic Impact

The dual enrollment/Early Admission student receives both high school and college credit upon successful completion of the course(s). For the high school academic record these courses are weighted the same as IB, AP and Honors courses. Since college credit is awarded, this grade will remain a part of the college academic transcript as well as the high school academic transcript.
